


Poster Challenge: Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

What should be the size of my poster?

Your illustration should be laid out on A4 page (210mm x 297mm) and vertical/portrait orientation.



What artistic media can I use?

Your poster needs to include a photograph that you have taken yourself. The photograph can be of anything you like that relates to your topic, however:

- 1. It must not be inappropriate (no images that some people might find confronting or illegal)
- 2. If anyone is in the photo, you must seek their written permission to be in the photograph.
- 3. You must have permission to take the photograph.

Can I copy ideas from other sources?

Your poster should be your original work. You must ensure any assets used meet copyright and privacy requirements.

I don't really consider myself a photographer. Can I still submit?

We hope to showcase a diversity of posters. You will not be judged on technical artistic skills. We encourage you to have a go and enjoy the process!

How do I submit my poster?

Your poster should be submitted <u>here</u>.

How many entries can I submit?

One entry per person will be considered.

Can people from all countries submit?

Yes, there are no residency requirements. Children and youth from all over the world are encouraged to submit their posters.

How many entries will be selected?

Upschool will select a number of posters for display on the website gallery, and may make them available for download by anyone! There will be an even smaller number selected for potential publication.

How old should I be to submit my poster?

We encourage children and youth up to 25 years of age to submit their entries.

Is there a prize or cash reward associated with the winning entries?

The selected entries may be displayed in our public gallery on Upschool.co. They may also be published in an upcoming publication, and made available for online reading and hard copy purchase globally. There is no prize or cash reward, nor any other type of reward, payment or royalty, associated with the selected entries.

How will the selected poster authors be notified?

The winners will be notified via email. We will also publish the list of winners on our social media pages, including but not limited to:
