Three friends were having a play date. They were pretending that they had just hopped off a space ship on Mars.



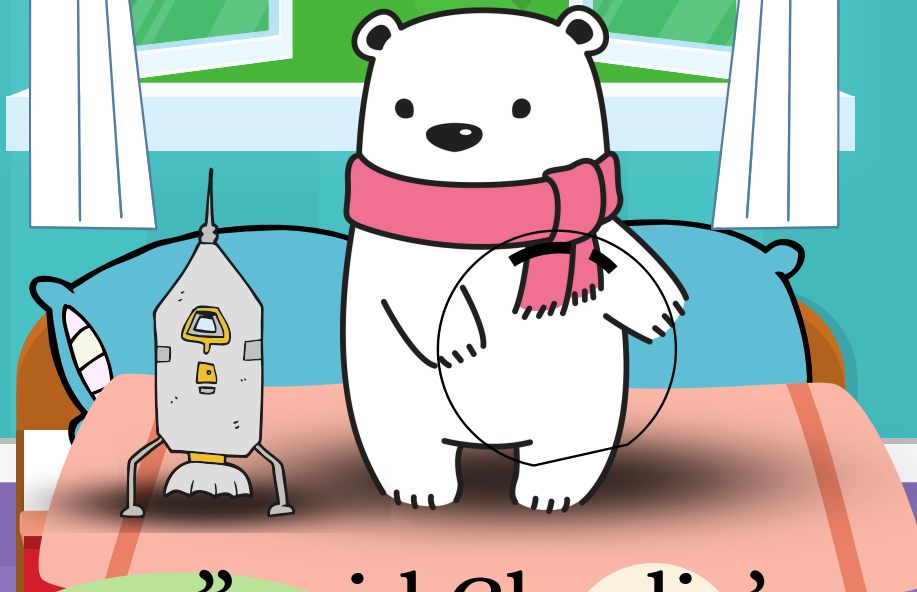
“Ding dong!”

“Aww!” said Charlie

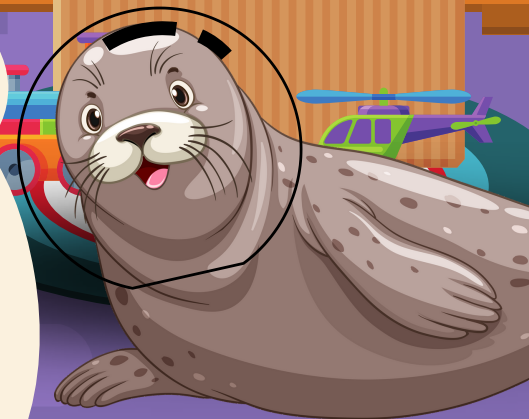
“We had just started our game!”

“Ok,” sighed Charlie.



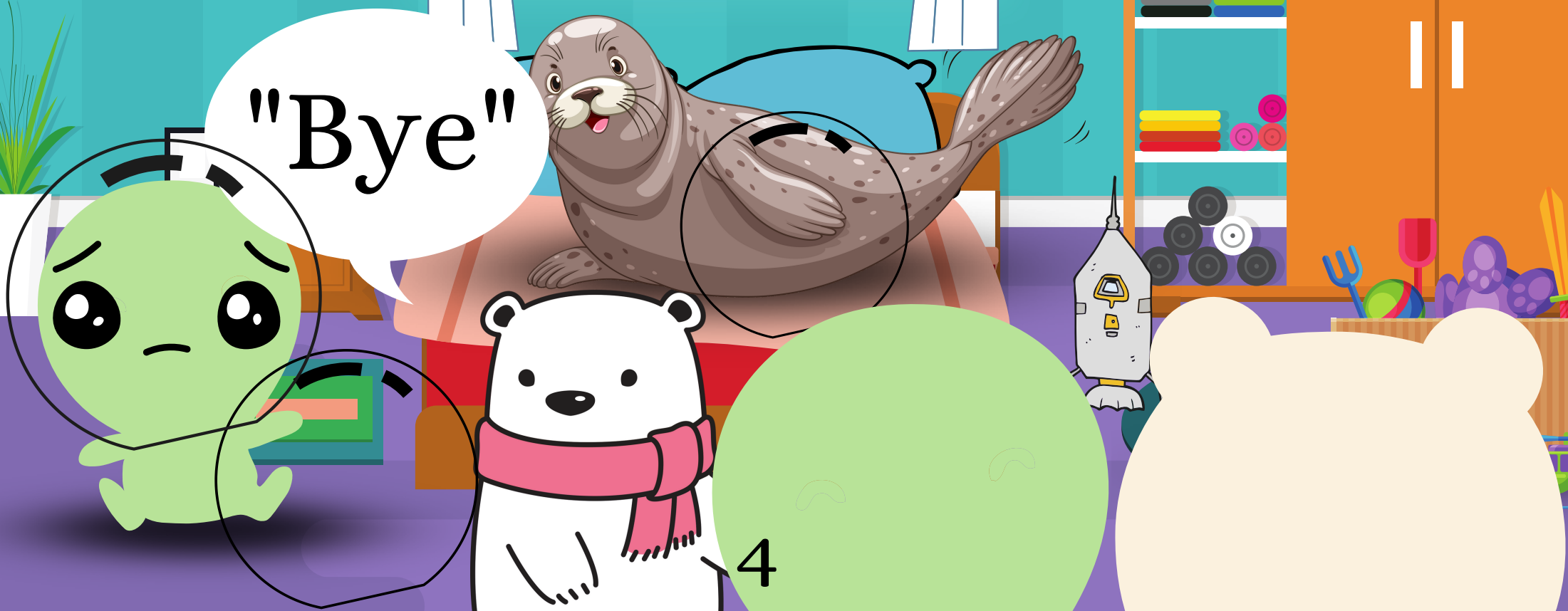
“At least you're staying for a sleepover Jackson,” said

in the boot and they drove off to NASA.



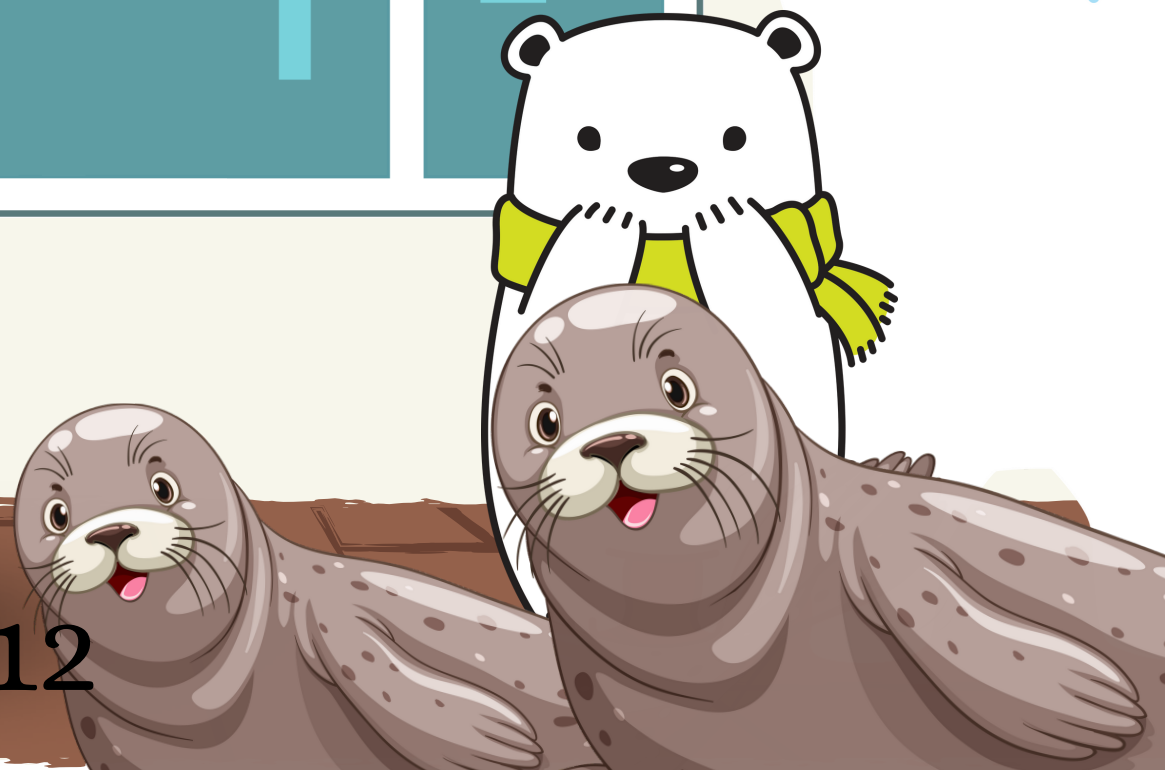
When they got to NASA, Charlie felt really nervous and his friends looked really nervous too.



Charlie had asked his mum if he would see her again. His mum told him that he would see her on the holidays. Charlie was

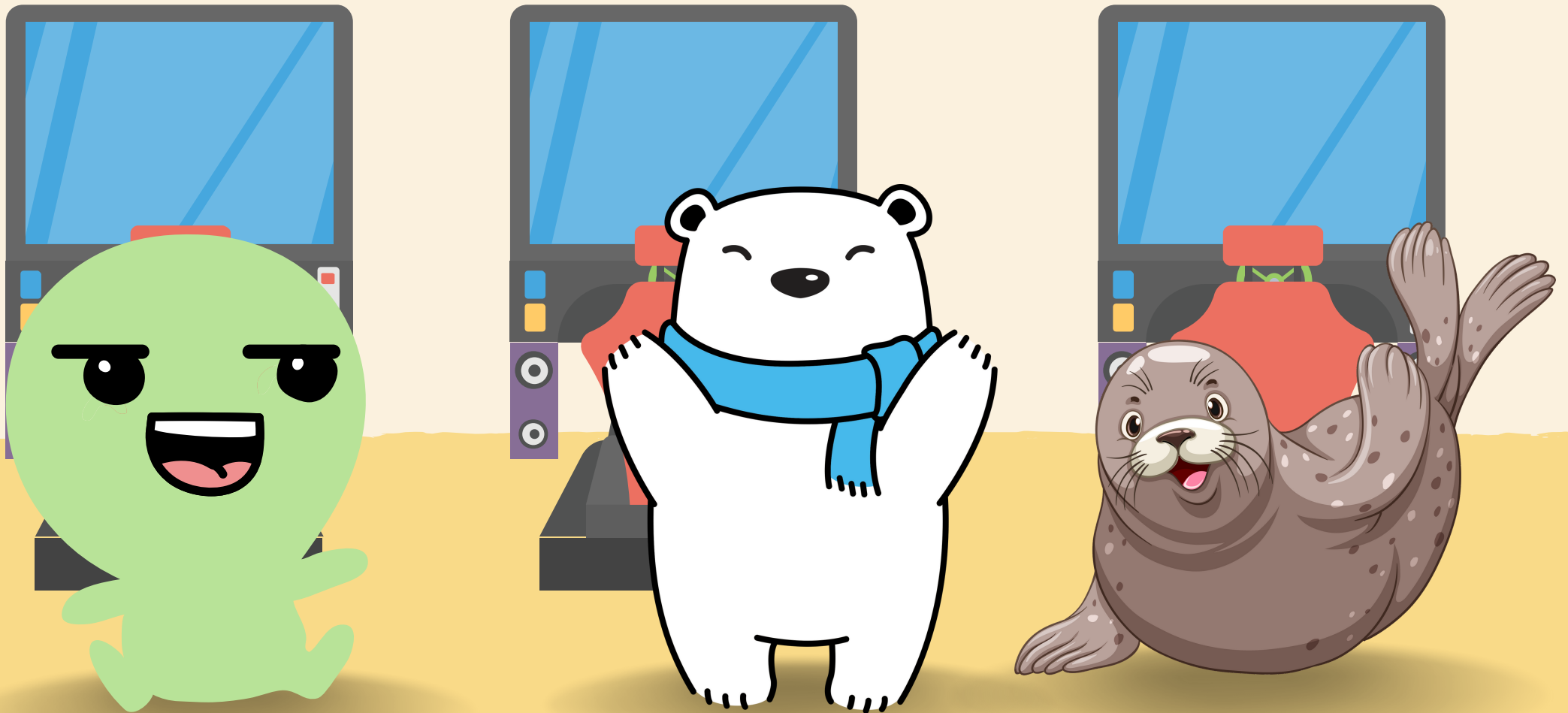
glad to hear that.

"Phew"



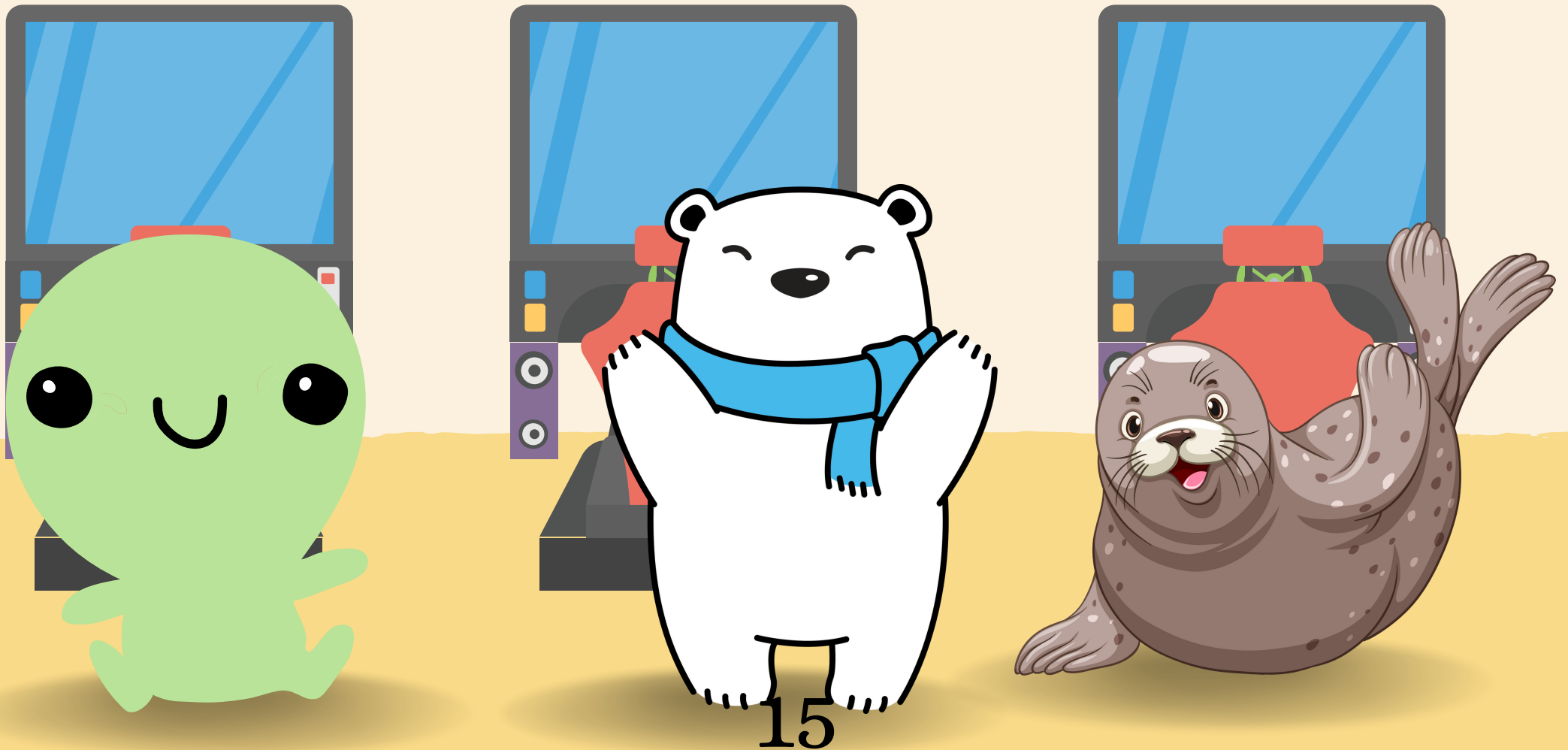
11 years later...

Charlie, Molly and Jackson all got a phone call saying that an alien was going to blow up Mars and they needed to go to save Mars.





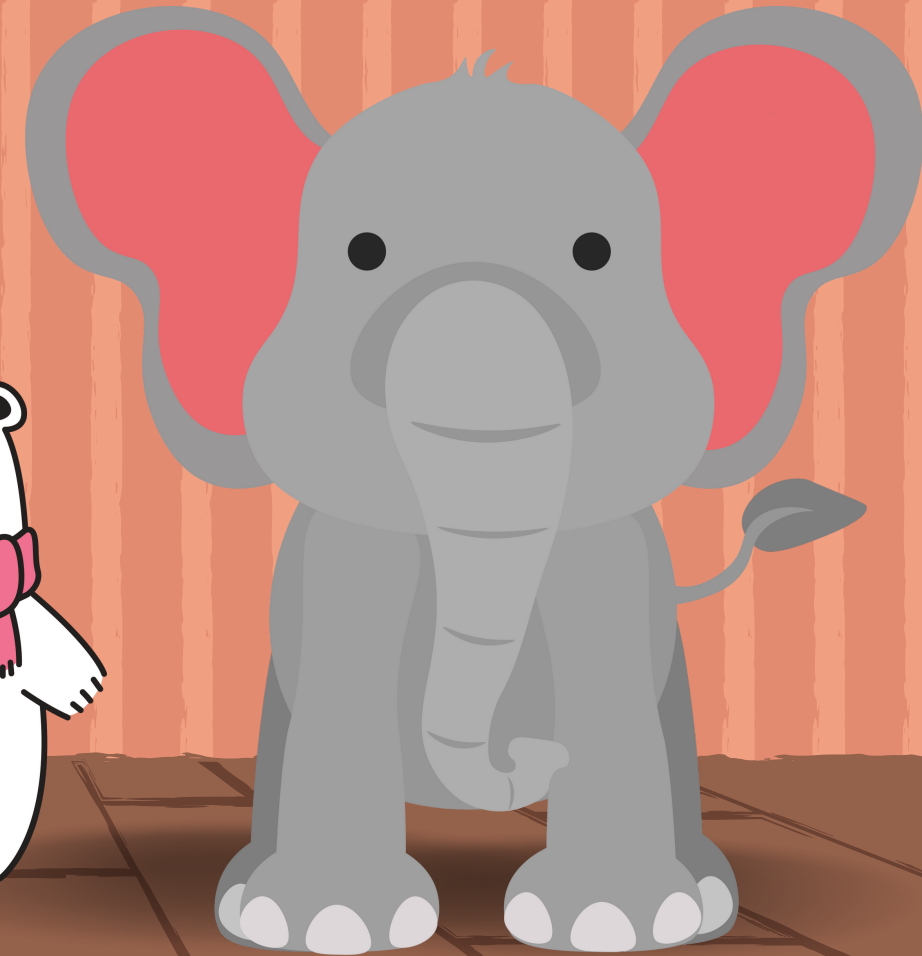

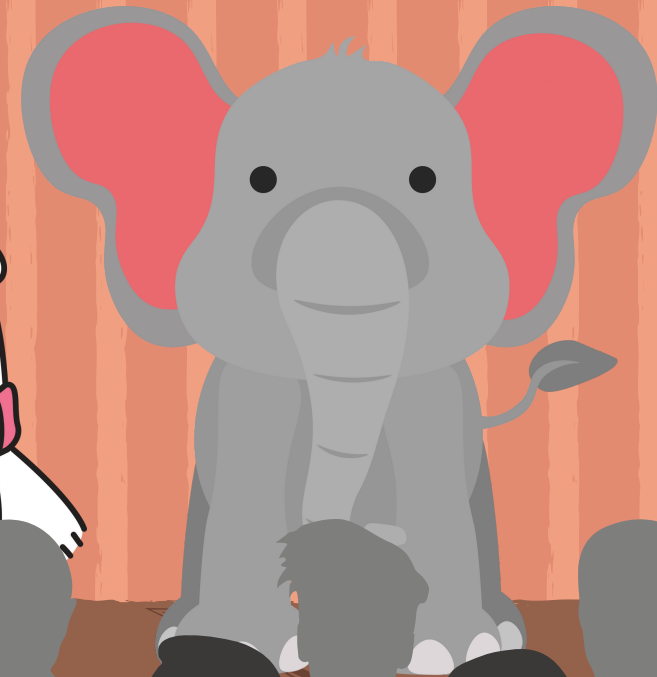
“The ship is launching in 10 minutes” the speakers said “

They were off and Charlie, Molly and Jackson were going to Mars

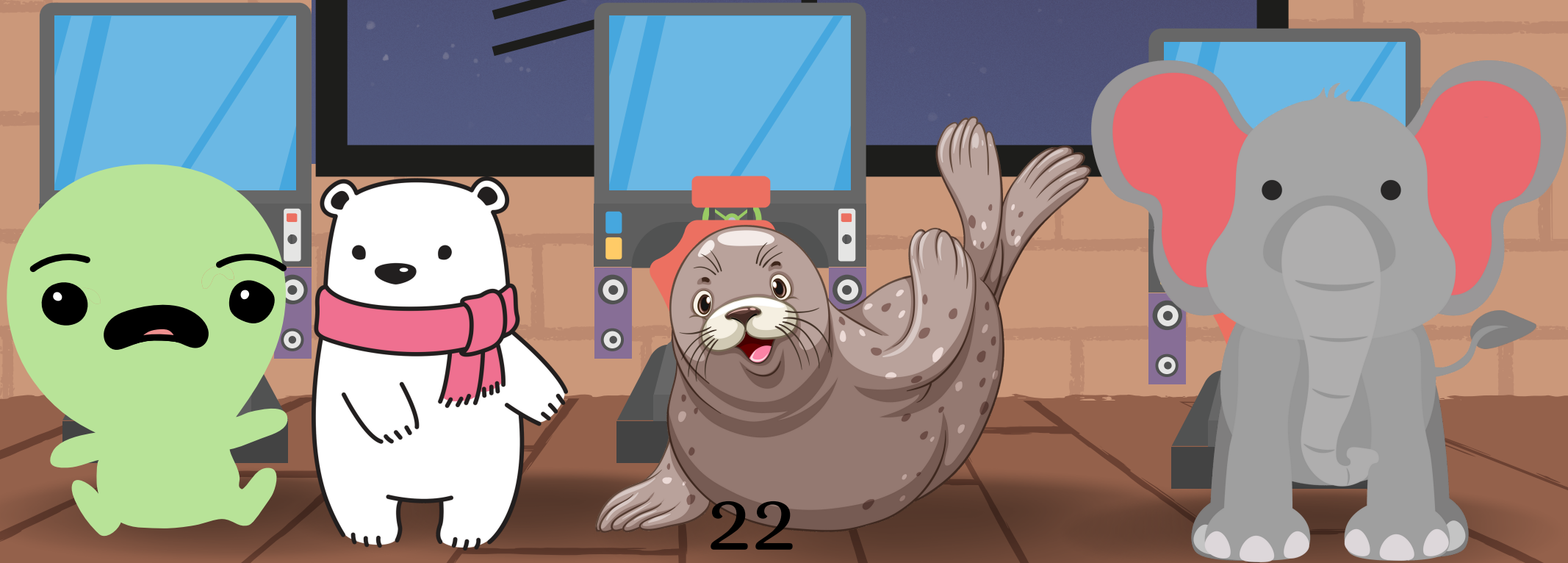
“ Captain, how long is this trip going to take?” asked Molly.

24in handcuffs.

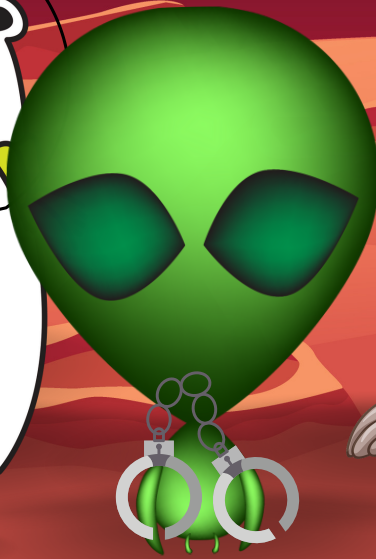


All of a sudden they heard rumbling. Charlie had accidentally kicked a rock and found a remote control.
