


Boiboi and the Great Cherry Day


It is finally the day that Boiboi has been waiting for, the Great Cherry Day!


Boiboi walks out into the village that is pumped up and ready to celebrate. He suddenly comes across a few young chibis who are unaware of the special day.




"What is going on?" asked one young-chibi.


The birth of the celebration began with a forest, then to building shelters, and eventually a small village. The chibis had settled with their lives but were on empty tummies and in dire need of food.


Boiboi suddenly catches the sight of his two rivals, Penny and Ham.

This is Boiboi's chanceto finally beat Penny and Ham.






Penny and Ham have yet again entered the race, followed by Boiboi. All three are now officially competing in the Great Cherry Race.


The time has finally come. Boiboi,

them.




"On your mark. Get Set. Go!" Yelled a chibi. Everyone starts cheering excitedly.


Some cheered for Penny and Ham, others cheered on Boiboi.








They ran as fast as they could, avoiding the mini cherries and kept their eyes out for the bigger cherry.

the three competitors come to a halt when they catch sight of the big cherry that is just inches away.



They all become very aggressive and start tugging onto the cherry intensely.


And then... the cherry slowly cracks and breaks!






The three chibi rivals can't believe what just happened. What have they done?

Everyone is shocked, the big cherry is now on the ground in pieces. It is a sad moment that happened so fast. All the chibis get upset and leave.







It is announced that no one wins the Great Cherry Race.

As Boiboi is sitting all alone he notices that all the chibis, including himself were starving.


Suddenly something catches his eyes.






The race track is still filled with cherries of all sizes. He knows what to do now.

Boiboi uses his initiative and begins to collect all the cherries along the track and packs them into baskets.






Boiboi realises that everyone can still celebrate the harvest of the other cherries despite their size. Penny and Ham see him and follow his lead.

All the baskets of cherries put together are bigger than the one big cherry itself.


It was such an accomplishment by the entire village. Nothing could go wrong now.


Boiboi, Penny and Ham have reconciled and are now friends.

Now everyone is happy and jolly!




