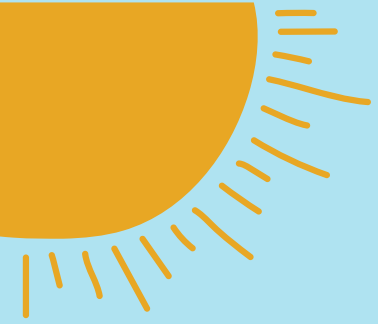

"Come in, you must be exhausted," Aunt Isabelle urged.



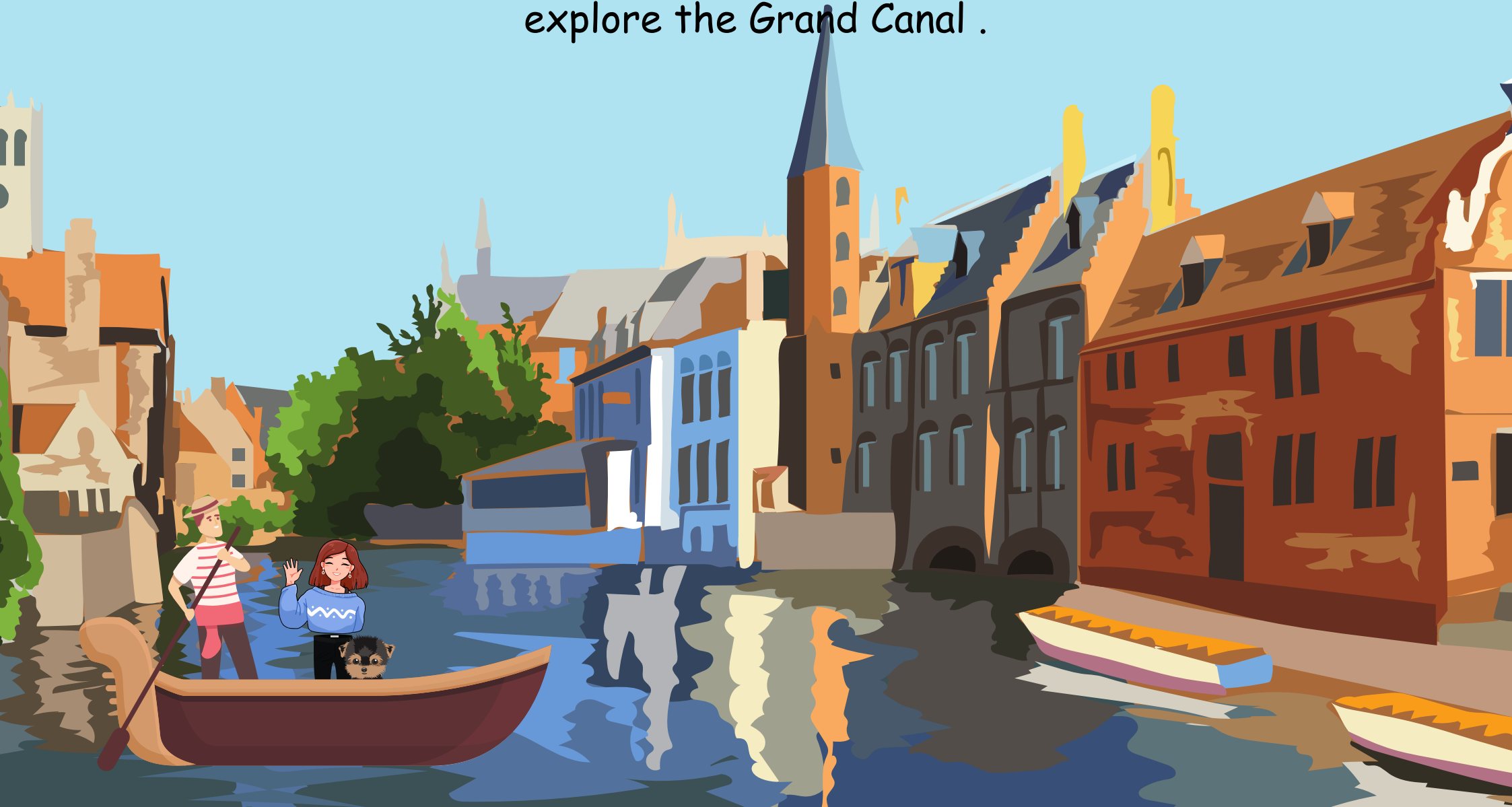
Evelyn, however, was not.

15 minutes later, she returned downstairs and set off into the alleys of Venice. She wanted to take a ride in a gondola to explore the Grand Canal .

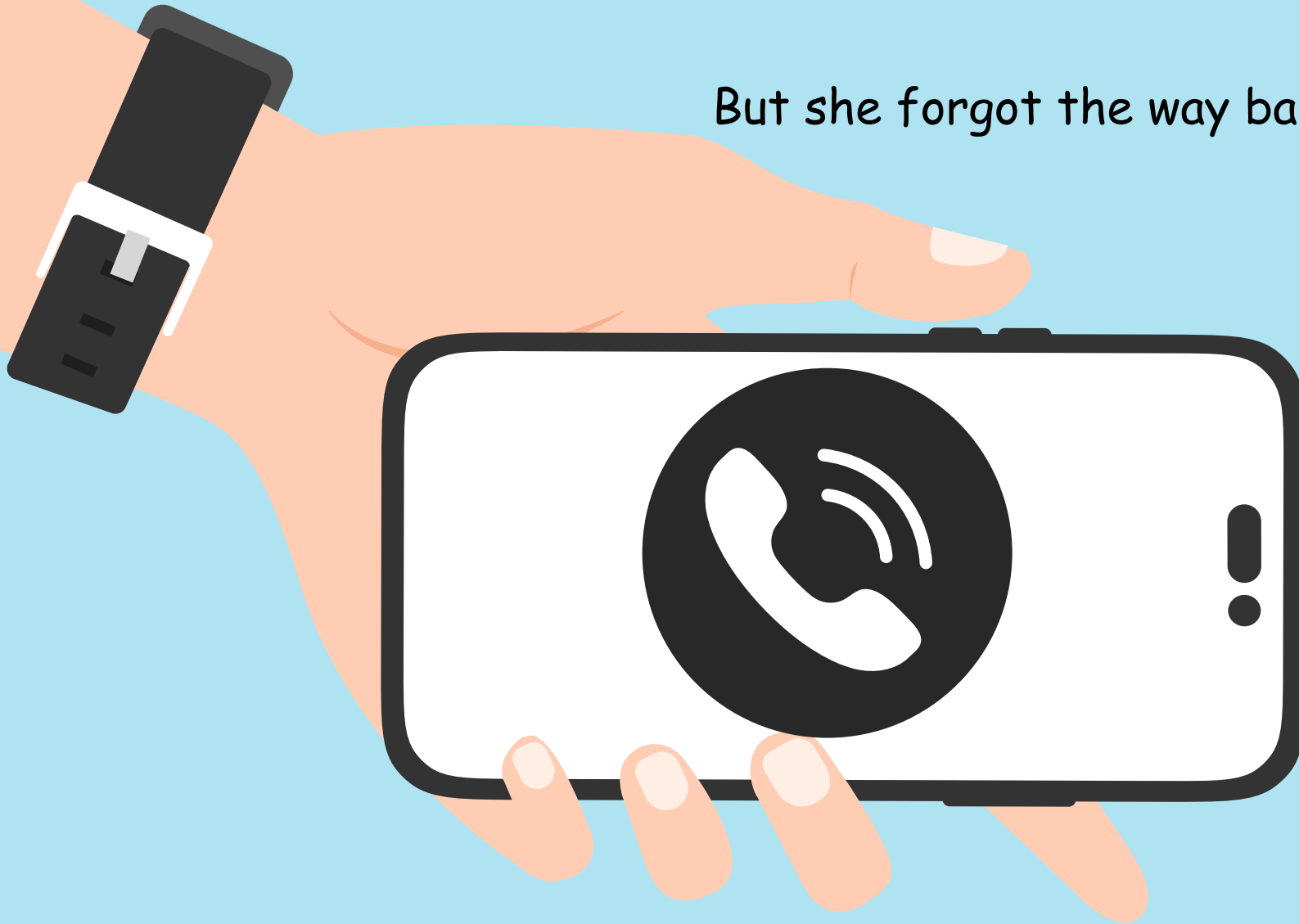





After a tour of the Grand Canal, she decided to walk back home

She requested directions from someone, but the man misheard her.

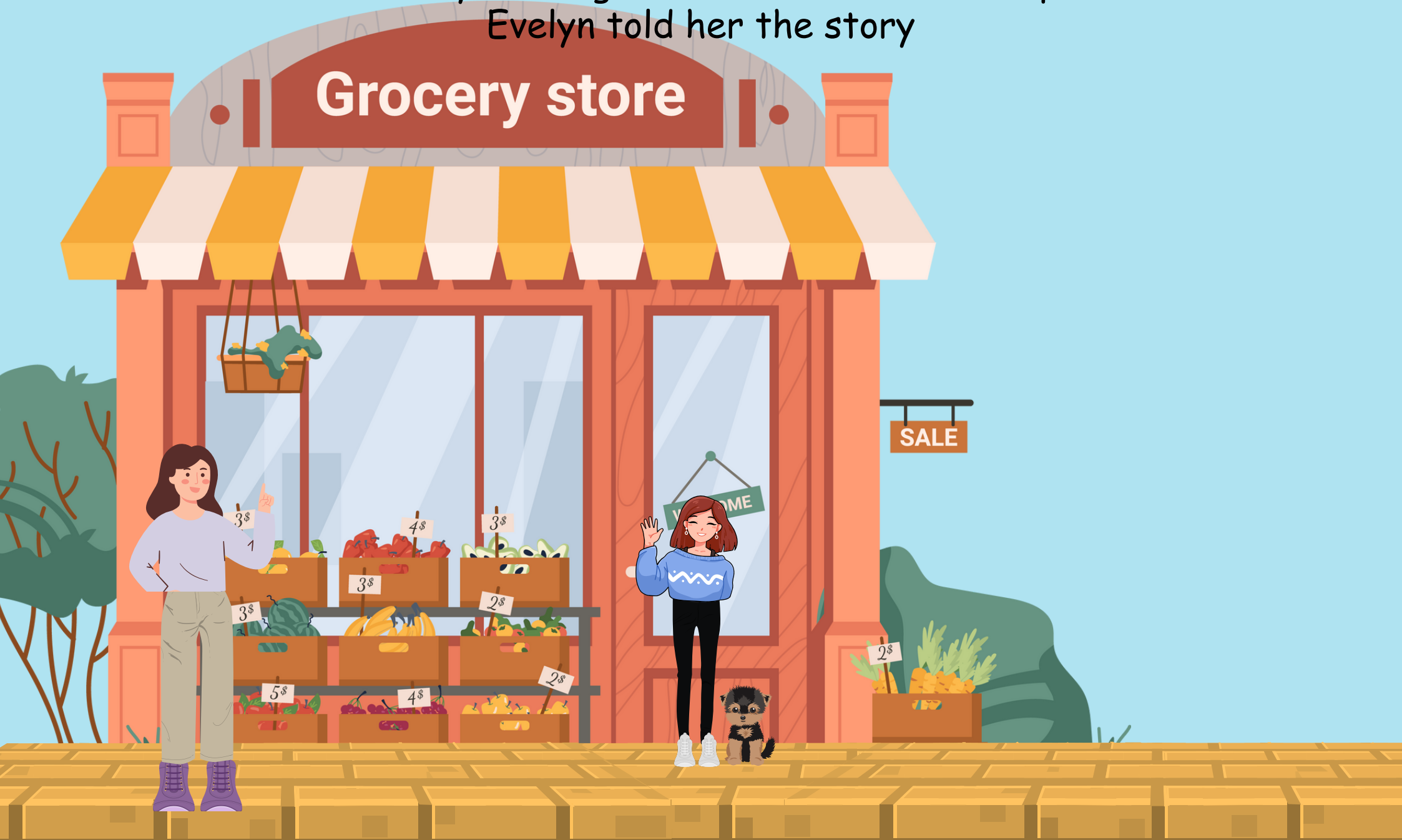


The directions from the man led her to a grocery shop.
She unexpectedly ran into someone... Aunt Isabelle?

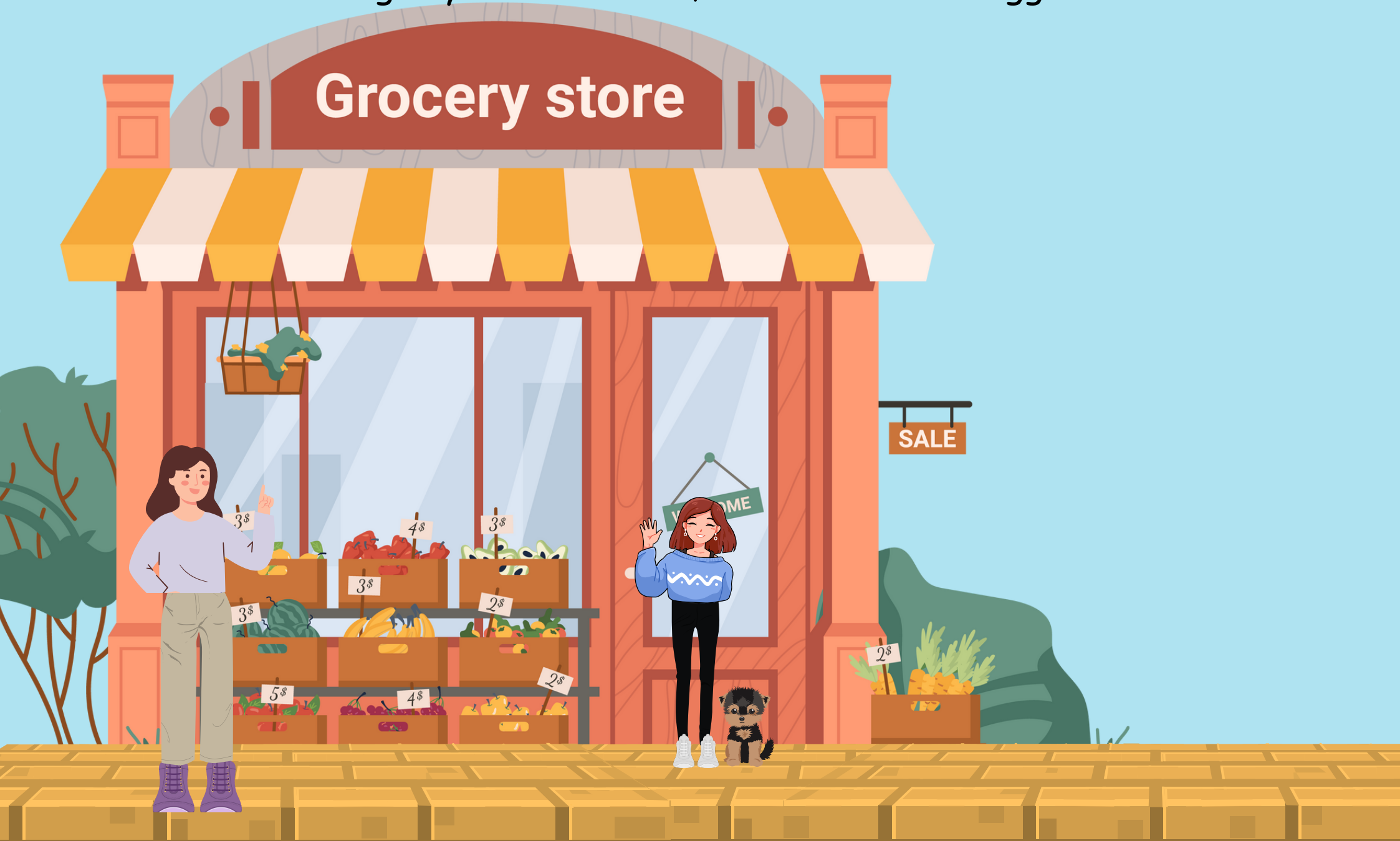
Grocery store
