













One day, they saw an orca being pulled up by some fishermen in a net. They got angry. So, Chrissy, with the help of her sharp claws, cut the net and the orca came

George thought something was wrong with Olivia. So he asked, "What's the matter, you seem upset. Is there anything we can do for you?"









Laughing, George replied, "Of course Olivia, there is no need to ask." Crissy replied to that, "Exactly!". On that note, Olivia danced with joy.
