They made a plan on how to stop bullying.



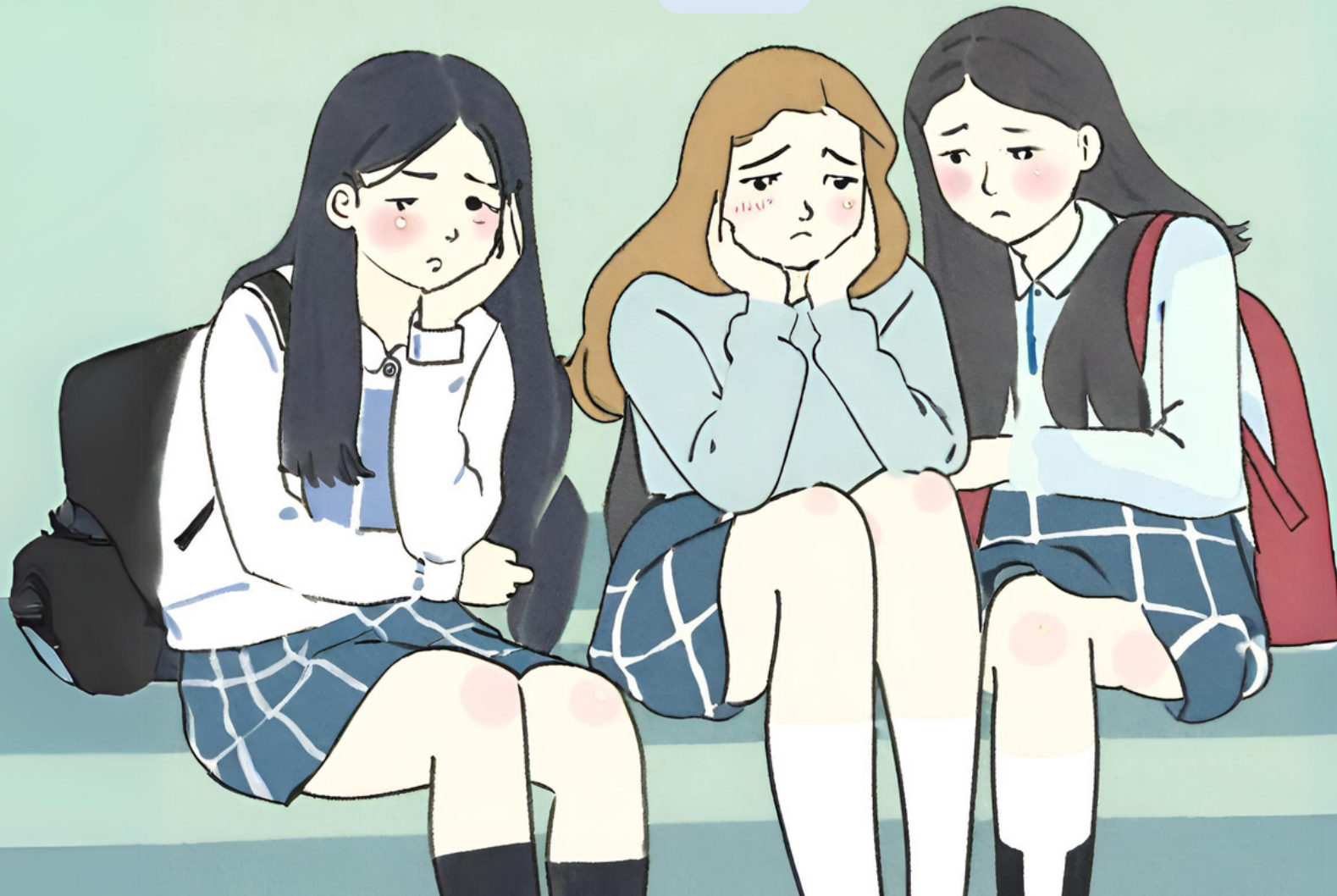


First, they made many posters to put around their school.

They told the bullies to stop and stood up for the people being bullied.



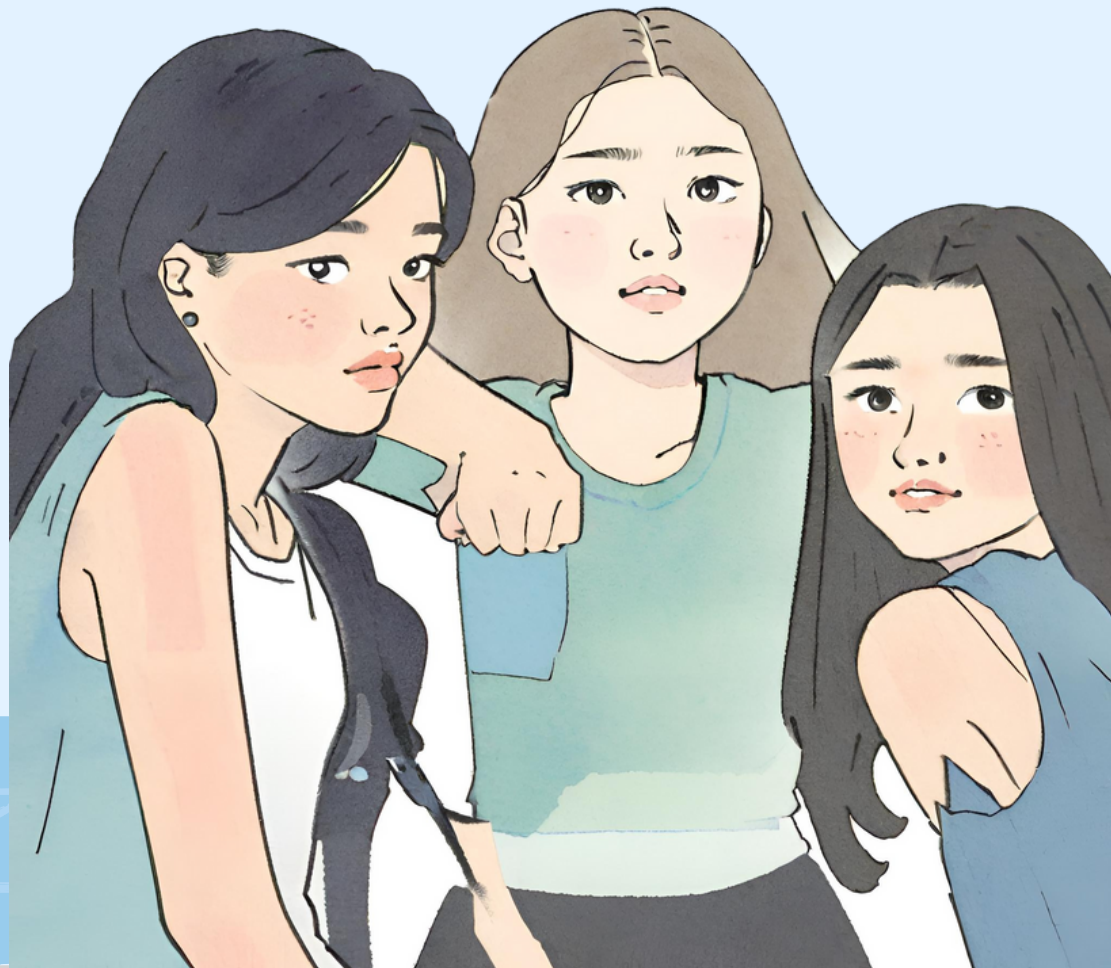
They also became friends with the kids that were being bullied.

Claire, Audrey, and Elise were out of ideas.



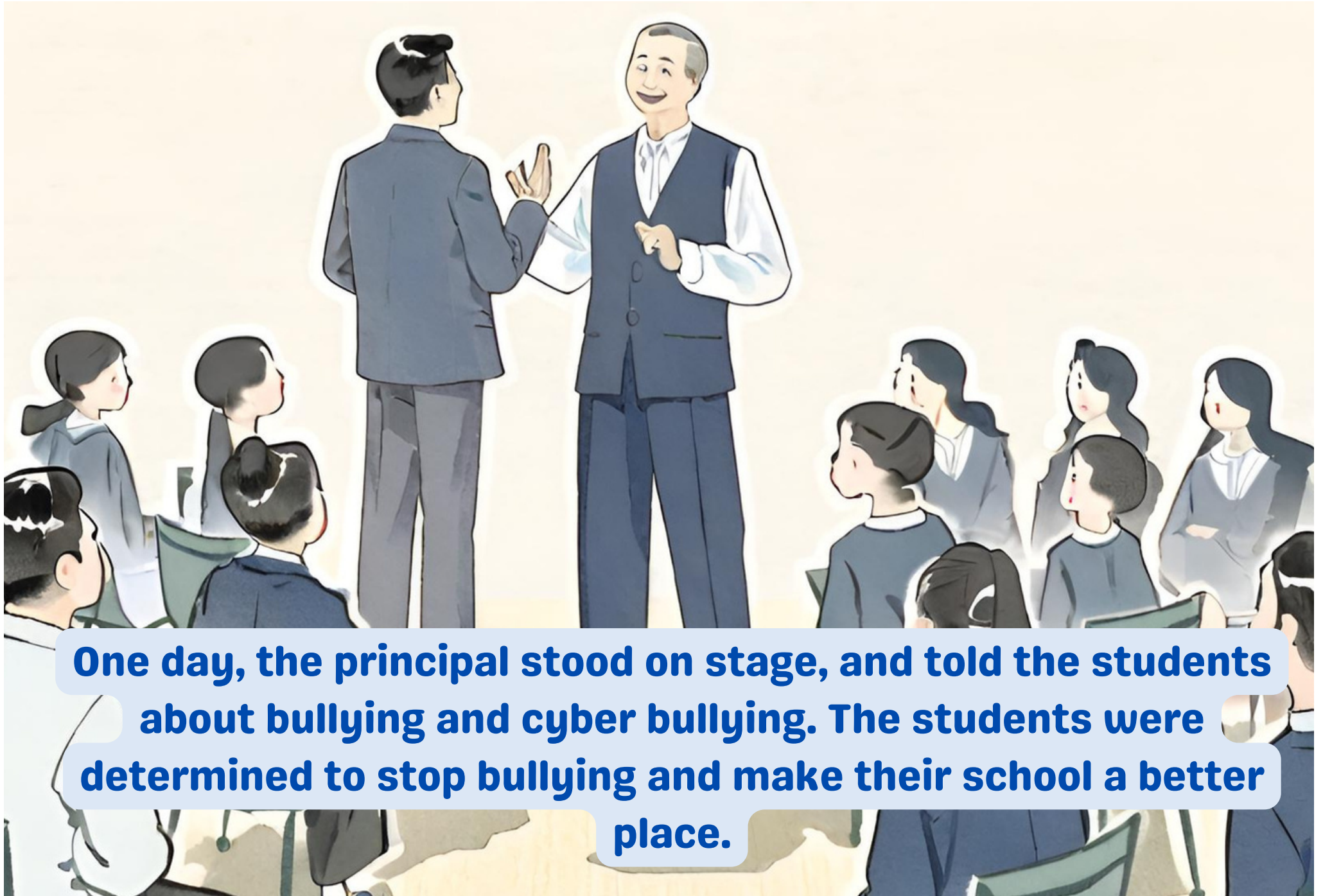

They decided that getting help from an adult was the best option. So they talked to Claire's mom, who's a teacher at Maple Oak High School.



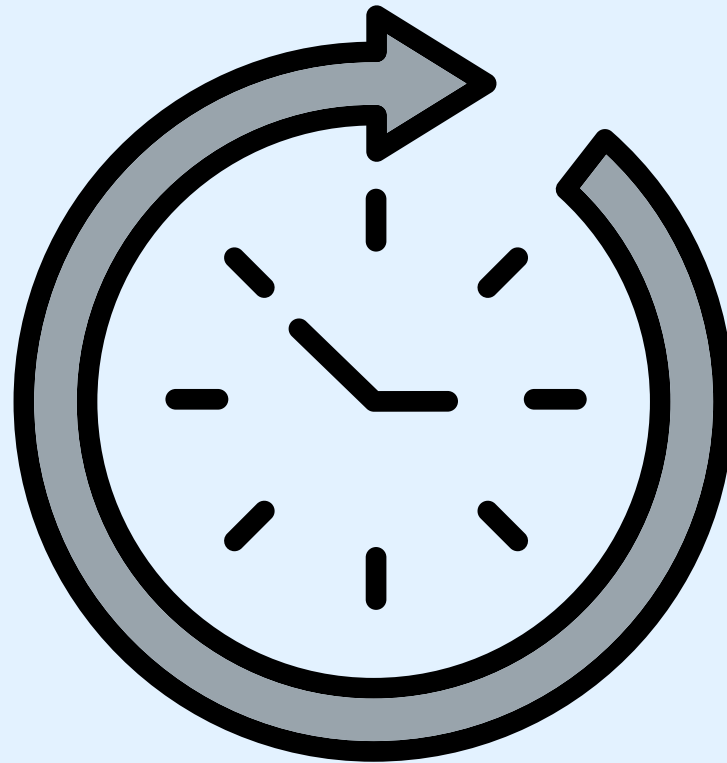
Claire's mom talked to the principal the next morning. The principal had said that he will talk to the students.

Soon after, bullying had completely vanished from Maple Oak High School.

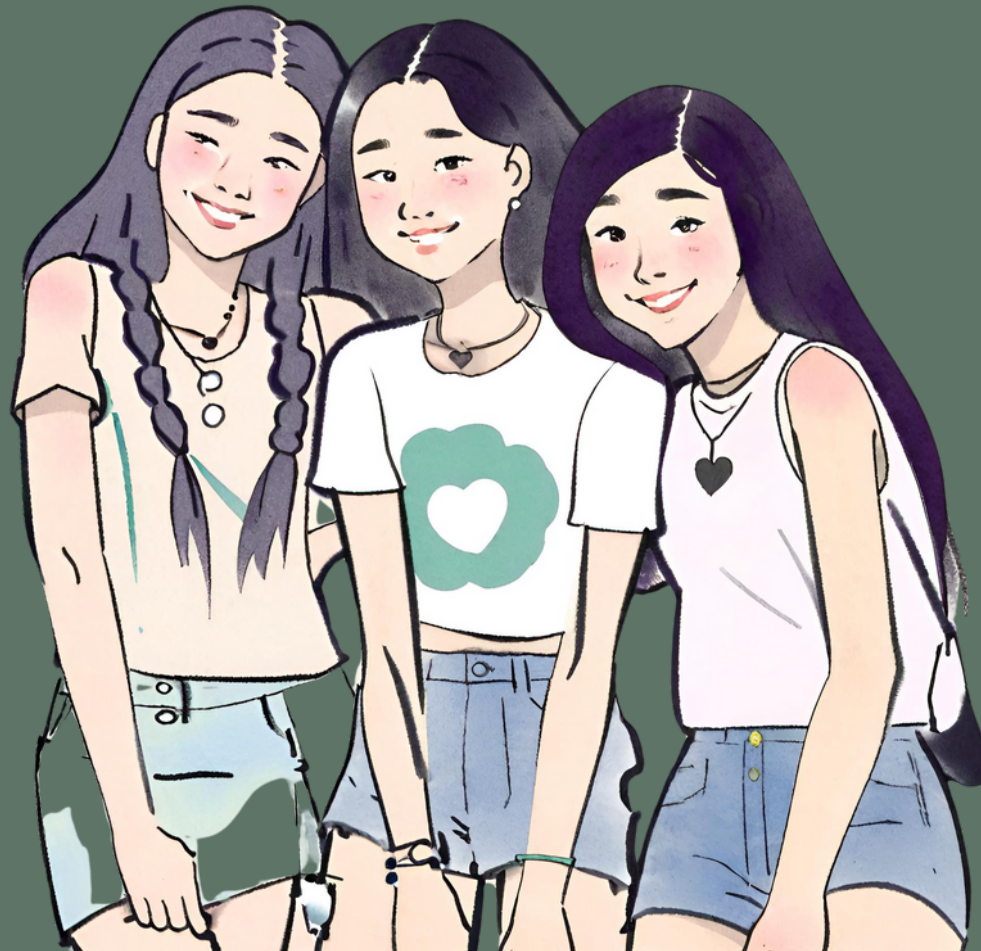


Students happily went to school without having to worry about being teased.

Claire, Audrey, and Elise finally reached their goal. They learnt that hard work always pays off.




Mahathi Rajarajan
