






Norman is a sad penguin. He is feeling blue...






and nobody knows why.

I went to play.






But Norman didn't want to play.

and sat...





His eyes lit up as soon as he saw the unexpected visitor. "Mum!" he cried, bounding into her flippers.




I was about to leave when, Norman stared into my hazel eyes. "Thank you." He spoke softly in almost a whisper.
