"Noooo!" Teddy whines as he refuses to sit down.





"Okay let's go explore the MOON!" Ruby yells with excitement.








BANG!! BOOM!! BOP!!! "Did we land! Have we landed?" Teddy asks as he starts gets even more excited.

"Last one on the Moon is a rotten egg!" Teddy yells. "Hey that's unfair you got a head start," Ruby whines.








"I don't want to be late for dinner. We are having pasta!"
